- Scope:** AYSO teams from Section 6 / Area E
- When:** Saturday & Sunday, June 25th through June 26th, 2011 –
- Where:** The tournament will be held at the Dubuque Soccer Complex. No pets are allowed at fields.
- Who:** AYSO boys and girls teams in age divisions: U-14 Co-ed (11v11) 18 maximum players Coed teams must consist of equal gender ratio if not must be preapproved by Regional commissioner and tournament director. U-12 Boys and Girls (11v11) 18 players max. and U-10 (9v9) 16 players max. U-8 (7v7) 12 player maximum. All players must be registered to play in the AYSO 2011 season. Guest players will be allowed per approved by the Regional Commissioner.
- What:** Pool play tournament/ Round Robin (if not enough teams for pools) Each team will be guaranteed 3 games in pool play. The top teams will advance to the medal round on Sunday afternoon. All games will be played within an hour. Two twenty five minute halves with a 5 minute half time.
- Why:** The Dubuque Soccer Fest Tournament is being conducted as a fundraiser by Dubuque Kiwanis in collaboration with Region 419 to raise funds for Kiwanis to give back to local children and in doing so the Dubuque Kiwanis is the main sponsor for the tournament.
